Notes of special interest:

In December we received donations totaling \$29,289 from 103 donors. This is the largest number of donors for any one month that we have experienced. Included in those 103 donors are 16 USSVI bases who donated a total of \$14,189 with the largest coming from the Crash Dive Base with \$10,000 for a future memorial project.

Our Year-to-Date Net Income is strong, and our portfolio is performing nicely. January is the last month in our fiscal year, and we will close out the year in a profitable position, barring any unforeseen calamity.
