All Charitable Foundation accounts have been reconciled with their respective bank and brokerage statements through February 28, 2022. All financial reports are attached below.

Notes of special interest:

In February we received donations totaling \$31,836 from forty-four donors. We received two donations of \$10,000 each, one from the Minneapolis Foundation to be used on the Minneapolis – St. Paul Memorial project. We also disbursed \$15,000 in support of that Memorial project. The second \$10,000 donation came from Gary Silverman to fully fund his Living Legacy Fund. At the end of February, we had three Living Legacy Funds established and on March 1, 2022, we received a fourth Living Legacy Fund pledge of \$10,000. These four funds total \$40,000 in pledges and we have received \$19,490 in funding against these pledges.

The Brotherhood Fund has one active support action in place with two additional cases of USSVI members with brain injuries wherein their bases have approached USSVCH in search of assistance. In both cases, we have been verbally supportive and are awaiting further action from each base.

Two years of COVID pandemic has caused some disruption in USSVI base activities, this has affected the Charitable Foundation as well. The recent invasion of Ukraine by Russia is another significant global disturbance, and all of this is affecting the stock market. These historical anomalies are reflected in our lower than normal monthly and annual financial performance.
