All Charitable Foundation accounts have been reconciled with their respective bank and brokerage statements through March 31, 2022. All financial reports are attached below.

Notes of special interest:

In March we received donations from 41 donors totaling \$8,909. This compares with March of 2021 when we received \$1,677. From 31 donors. We continue to receive donations from new donors; these new donors are welcomed. In March we received a quarterly donation from AmazonSmile with another increased amount, marking a string of increased amounts earned from AmazonSmile.

During the first two months of this fiscal year, our Brotherhood Fund has assisted several shipmates with a total of \$9,300 in assistance. Additionally, we have disbursed \$18,350 in award checks for Memorials. We are seeing a broader awareness of the Charitable Foundation activities, another welcomed indication of broader awareness. Our Scholarship Fund Manager is fielding many applications for the upcoming school year. All of this is good.

For several years the CF has assisted the Silverdale office with periodic financial reimbursements to cover some of their overhead. During the previous fiscal year, we inadvertently omitted that reimbursement and this month we have made up for last year and all the current year. This is a one-time expense of \$4,800. Future support amounts will be reduced due to a reduction in the support we need from that office.
