All Charitable Foundation accounts have been reconciled with their respective bank and brokerage statements through November 30, 2021. All financial reports are attached below.

**Notes of special interest:**

In November we received several large donations, including \$10,000 from Sue Greenfeld, daughter of Theresa Robertson, who bequeathed this amount in honor of her deceased husband, Cdr. Robert Robertson, Past Commander of Submarine Veterans of WW II. This donation was designated for the Scholarship Fund. The Minneapolis Foundation sent us two checks totaling \$20,000 to be used for a Memorial Float to be used by the Minneapolis St. Paul Base. Lastly, we received \$6,740 in donations for the newly planned Lost Boat Memorial for the Sacramento River Walk Park located in West Sacramento. Our monthly Net Income was \$15,665 resulting in a year-to-date Net Loss of a little over \$400. This leaves us in a good financial position with two months left in our fiscal year and strong indications that the #GivingTuesday campaign will result in strong donation activity.

Our donations for November totaled \$39,960 from 56 donors. This reflects a carry-over from the USSVI National Convention in Orlando as well as a strong and meaningful presence in the "*American Submariner*". For comparison, November 2020 had 52 donors for a total of \$3,845.
